1. Victory Capital Management Inc. claims compliance with the Global Investment Performance Standards (GIPS®) and has prepared and presented this report in compliance with the GIPS standards. Victory Capital Management Inc. has been independently verified for the periods January 1, 2001 through December 31, 2025. The verification report is available upon request. A firm that claims compliance with the GIPS standards must establish policies and procedures for complying with all the applicable requirements of the GIPS standards. Verification provides assurance on whether the firm's policies and procedures related to composite and pooled fund maintenance, as well as the calculation, presentation, and distribution of performance, have been designed in compliance with the GIPS standards and have been implemented on a firm-wide basis. Verification does not provide assurance on the accuracy of any specific performance report.
2. Victory Capital Management Inc. (VCM) is a diversified global investment adviser registered under the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 and comprises multiple investment franchises: Integrity Asset Management, New Energy Capital Partners, Pioneer Investments, RS Investments, Sycamore Capital, Trivalent Investments, Victory Income Investors, and the Victory Capital Solutions Platform. RS Investments and Sophus Capital became a part of the VCM GIPS firm effective January 1, 2017; Victory Income Investors, effective July 1, 2019; THB Asset Management, effective March 1, 2021; New Energy Capital effective November 1, 2021; and Amundi Asset Management US, Inc. (renamed to "Pioneer Investments"), effective April 1, 2025. Effective July 1, 2025, Newbridge Asset Management, Sophus Capital and THB Asset Management are no longer part of the GIPS firm. Effective December 1, 2025, Munder Capital Management is no longer part of the GIPS firm.
3. The Pioneer US Large Cap Growth Equity Strategy seeks long-term capital appreciation by investing primarily in equity securities of US large cap companies. The Strategy seeks to accomplish this through an actively-managed, fundamentally-driven approach that focuses on bottom-up research. The Strategy relies on internal research to identify companies that generate high returns on growth capital, possess a sustainable competitive advantage, and have the ability to capitalize on secular trends. The composite creation date is December 1993, and the composite inception date is January 1, 1994. The benchmark of the composite is the Russell 1000 Growth Index.

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4. The benchmark of the composite is the Russell 1000® Growth Index. The Russell 1000® Growth Index is an unmanaged market-capitalization weighted index that measures the performance of those companies in the Russell 1000® Index (which consists of the 1,000 largest US companies based on total market capitalization) with higher price-to-book ratios and higher forecasted growth values. The benchmark returns are provided to represent the investment environment existing during the time periods shown and are not covered by the report of independent verifiers. For comparison purposes, the index is fully invested, which includes the reinvestment of income. The returns have been taken from a published source and do not include any transaction fees, management fees, or other costs.
5. The internal dispersion of annual returns is measured by the standard deviation of asset-weighted gross returns of accounts included in the composite for the full year. If less than six portfolios are included in the composite for the full year, no dispersion measure is presented, as it is not considered meaningful (N/M). The three-year annualized ex-post standard deviation measures the variability of the composite's gross returns, and the benchmark returns over the preceding 36-month period. It is not required to be presented for annual periods when a full three years of composite performance is not yet available.
6. Composite and benchmark returns are presented net of non-reclaimable withholding taxes. Gross-of-fees returns are presented before management and custodial fees but after all transaction costs. Net-of-fees returns are calculated by deducting 1/12 of the highest tier of the standard fee schedule in effect for the period noted (the model fee). The composite model fee for each period is either the highest tier of the current fee schedule or a higher value, whichever is required to ensure the model composite net-of-fee return is lower than or equal to the composite net-of-fee return calculated using actual fees. Actual fees may vary depending on, among other things, the applicable fee schedule and portfolio size. The composite includes a limited distribution pooled fund (Pioneer Large Cap Growth Collective Fund). The highest fee schedule is 0.65% and the total expense ratio for the Collective fund 0.73%. 8. The composite is managed by Pioneer Investments (formerly Amundi Asset Management US, Inc. Performance prior to April 2025 occurred while the team was affiliated with a prior firm. Such members of the portfolio management team were responsible for investment decisions at the prior firm, and the decision-making process has remained intact. The historical performance has been linked to performance earned at Victory Capital Management Inc.
