Investment Objective and Strategy

The Fund seeks to provide a high level of current income. The Fund normally invests at least 80% of its net assets in floating rate loans and other floating rate investments. Most of the Fund's investments will typically be below investment grade. The investment team considers several factors such as the issuer's credit quality, management, capital structure, leverage, operational performance and the business outlook for the industry of the issuer.

About the Fund

- Invests in "senior" loans, which typically hold a senior position in the capital structure of the borrower, are typically secured by specific collateral, and have a claim on the assets and/or stock of the borrower that is senior to that held by subordinated debtholders and stockholders of the borrower.
- Index agnostic and high conviction bank loan strategy.

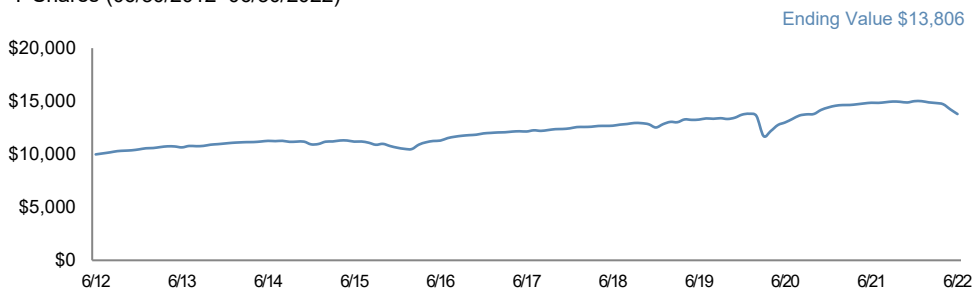

Morningstar Category: Bank Loan. Morningstar ratings and rankings are based on the Y share class.

The Morningstar Rating™ for funds, or "star rating," is calculated for managed products (including mutual funds, variable annuity and variable life subaccounts, exchange-traded funds, closed-end funds, and separate accounts) with at least a three-year history. Exchange-traded funds and open-ended mutual funds are considered a single population for comparative purposes. It is calculated based on a Morningstar Risk-Adjusted Return measure that accounts for variation in a managed product's monthly excess performance, placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. The Morningstar Rating does not include any adjustment for sales loads. The top 10% of products in each product category receive 5 stars, the next 22.5% receive 4 stars, the next 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 2 stars, and the bottom 10% receive 1 star. The Overall Morningstar Rating for a managed product is derived from a weighted average of the performance figures associated with

its three-, five-, and 10-year (if applicable) Morningstar Rating metrics. The weights are: 100% three-year rating for 36-59 months of total returns, 60% five-year rating/40% three-year rating for 60-119 months of total returns, and 50% 10-year rating/30% five-year rating/20% three-year rating for 120 or more months of total returns. While the 10-year overall star rating formula seems to give the most weight to the 10-year period, the most recent three-year period actually has the greatest impact because it is included in all three rating periods. The Morningstar percentile ranking is based on a fund's average annual total return (excluding sales charges) relative to all funds in the same category. The highest (most favorable) percentile rank is 1%, and the lowest (least favorable) percentile rank is 100%. Fund performance used for the rankings reflects certain fee waivers, without which, Morningstar rankings would have been lower and Morningstar ratings may have been lower.

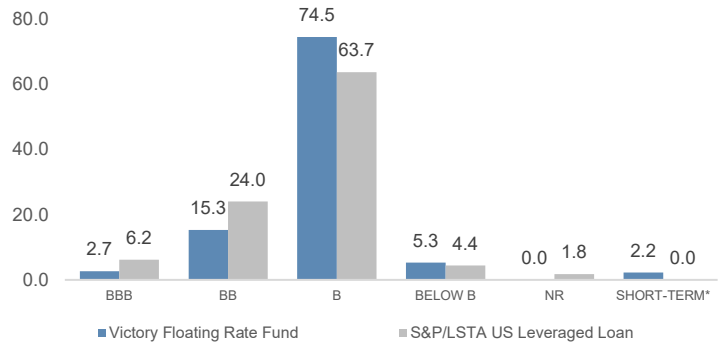

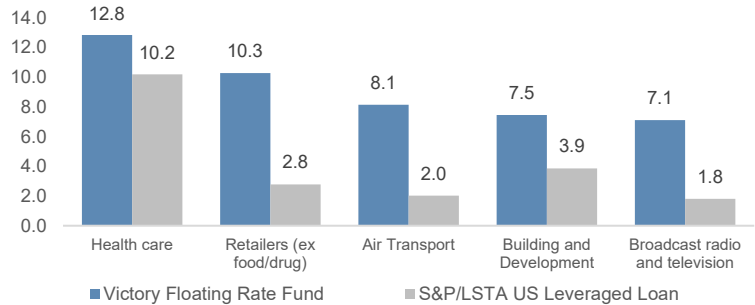

Credit Quality ratings are obtained using Bloomberg methodology using ratings derived from Moody's Investors Service (Moody's), Standard & Poor's (S&P) and Fitch Ratings (Fitch). When one rating is available, that rating is used. Victory Capital Management does not evaluate these ratings but simply assigns the to the appropriate credit quality category as determined by the rating agency. **Subsidized Yield** reflects fee waivers/reimbursements/limits in effect. **Unsubsidized Yield** does not reflect

any fee waivers/reimbursements/limits in effect. **Index agnostic** means the fund is benchmark and industry aware but not benchmark driven.

The S&P/LSTA (Loan Syndications and Trading Association) Leveraged Loan Index covers more than 1,100 loan facilities and reflects the market-value-weighted performance of U.S. dollar denominated institutional leveraged loans.

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The Refinitiv Lipper Fund Awards are based on the Lipper Leader for Consistent Return rating, which is a risk-adjusted performance measure calculated over 36, 60 and 120 months. The fund with the highest Lipper Leader for Consistent Return (Effective Return) value in each eligible classification wins the Refinitiv Lipper Fund Award. Victory Floating Rate Fund Class Y was selected from among 53 funds and 217 share classes in the loan participation fund category over five years for the period ending November 30, 2021.
